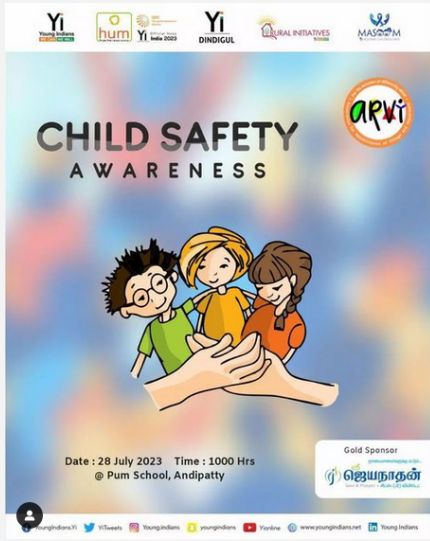
Kamaraj's birthday Event

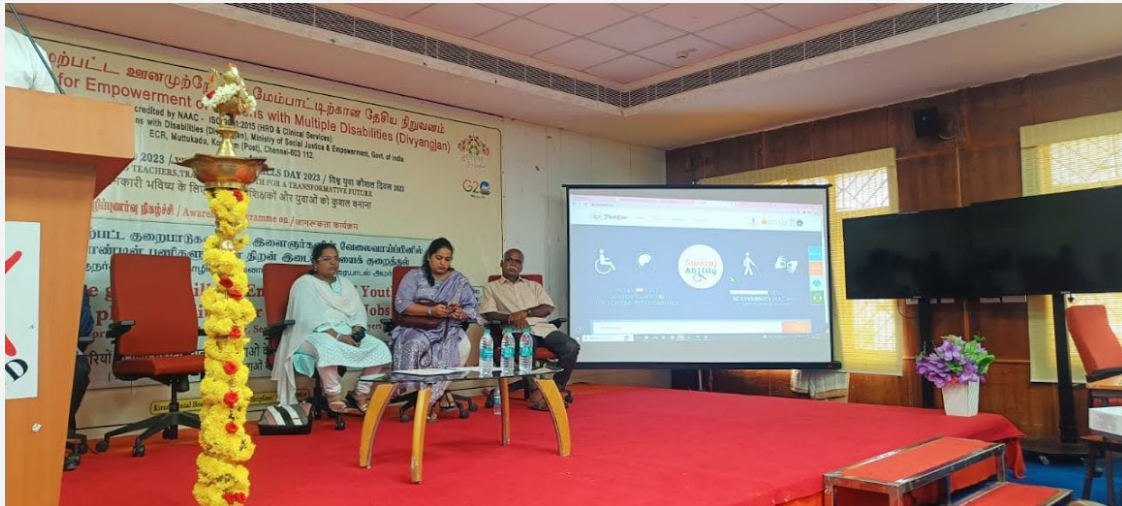

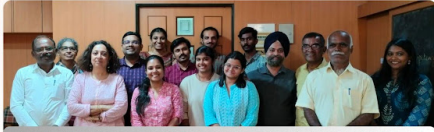
